Some restrictions ease in Queensland

Yesterday Premier Annastacia Palaszczuk announced borders will reopen from 10 July to visitors from all states and territories other than Victoria.

The [Roadmap to easing Queensland's restrictions](#) was also updated with changes such as office-based workers can return to their place of work from 3 July. We ask that you continue to be flexible and patient as there is no update on when State Library staff will return to working in the office.

We are progressing with preparation work and a COVID-Safe Site Plan for Stage 3 reopening of additional spaces.
