Additional spaces opening to the public

On Monday 22 June, in addition to the Infozone, The Edge and Anzac Square Memorial Galleries will reopen for limited activities.

The Library Shop has been operating online during our building closure and from 22 June will also reopen onsite.

Staff and clients will be required to adhere to social distancing requirements and hygiene measures.

Queensland Art Gallery and Queensland Museum will also reopen on Monday.

Next steps

Last week State Library submitted to Queensland Health a detailed COVID-Safe Site Plan outlining a process to safely reopen the building to visitors and staff consistent with Queensland Government directives, guidelines and resources.

The Recovery Working Group is overseeing the planning for the reopening of additional public spaces as part of State Library's recovery plan.

This week, Queensland Health will conduct a site inspection of State Library and Anzac Square Memorial Galleries.

We are all responsible as employees to following these processes as we gradually reopen the building, with an emphasis on everyone's health and safety.

Ad hoc access to the building reminder

For staff requiring *ad hoc* access to the building, you will need to seek approval from your Executive Director. Your request should include date and times and if you require a car space. Please submit your requests a minimum of 24 hours prior to when access is required. At Reception you will need to sign in/out of Sine Pro and be issued with a temporary access pass by Security.

Keep in mind a Risk Assessment is required for all multiple-staff and front-facing activities before work commences and staff return to site. The template is available on the [COVID-19 staff updates webpage](#).

Grey Street Road Closure

The north bound lane of Grey Street (between Melbourne and Russell Streets) will be closed on Monday 22 June between 9am and 3pm. Traffic control will be on site and detours will be in place to facilitate this closure.
