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Reminder: masks are compulsory in libraries

South Bank staff must wear face masks whenever you are in our front of house spaces. This includes all areas where members of the public could go (such as the public lifts, reception, walkways and balconies on each level), **even if State Library is not open at the time.**

Our back of house spaces are a defined workplace, so you do not need to wear a face mask in these areas if you are able to maintain physical distancing of 1.5m and one person per 4m². But you should always keep your mask with you so you can put it on, if required.
