Lockdown extended in Brisbane

This morning Queensland Premier Annastacia Palaszczuk announced that the [lockdown will continue in Brisbane](#) until 6pm Saturday 3 July.

As a result, State Library will remain closed on Saturday 3 July. Pending further advice tomorrow, we plan to reopen State Library on Sunday 4 July. Anzac Square Memorial Galleries will also reopen on Sunday.

South Bank and Cannon Hill staff **can return to the workplace once the lockdown concludes**. Based on current advice, this will be from Monday 5 July for non-weekend staff.

We will contact all staff over the weekend via the SMS broadcast system to confirm this advice, following the updates from Queensland Health tomorrow. We will also share the information on the [staff updates page](#).

Please make sure your contact details are up to date in Aurion (accessible via RD Web). Staff who have recently commenced with State Library should talk directly with their People Leader if they need assistance. If you don't receive an SMS over the weekend, please ensure you check the staff updates page instead.

Reminders for the workplace

Face masks

Please remember that if you **are in** or **have been in** South East Queensland **since 1am 29 June 2021**, you **must wear a** [face mask](#) **when you leave home**, unless you have a lawful reason not to.

Masks must be worn at all times when working or moving through front of house spaces. This includes lifts and foyers on each level — anywhere where the public can go.

Masks do not need to be worn back of house if you can maintain 1.5m from others, but you should carry one with you throughout the day so that you can put it on if you are unable to maintain 1.5m (for example, when working in meeting rooms or in close proximity to others at your workspace).

Signing in

In accordance with Queensland Government directives, **all staff must check in using the Check In Qld app when they arrive at State Library at South Bank or Anzac Square.** Sine Pro is no longer being used to manage staff check-ins at South Bank or Anzac Square.

If you don't have a smartphone or don't want to install the Check In Queensland app, you can check in using the iPads instead.

Staff at Cairns and Cannon Hill will continue to use Sine Pro.
