Confirmed COVID-19 case in Brisbane community

A COVID-19 case confirmed overnight appears to be locally acquired. He has been infectious in the community since last Friday.

Queensland Health will issue a Public Health Alert later today with specific locations and times, and contact tracing is underway. Some more information is currently available from [Queensland Premier Anastacia Palaszczuk](#).

We are closely monitoring the situation and will provide further advice if necessary. Please keep an eye on updates from Queensland Health.

In the coming days, it will be crucial to remain vigilant.

Remember:

- stay home if you are unwell
- maintain 1.5m from others
- keep up the good hygiene
- make sure you check in to venues
- consider wearing a mask in busy areas where you cannot keep a safe distance from others.

If you notice any symptoms, [get tested](#) and stay home. If you are going for test, advise your People Leader and [People, Projects and Learning](#) immediately and do not come to the workplace while you are awaiting test results. You then need to notify your People Leader and PPL as soon as you receive your result.
