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State Library will close from 3.30pm today due to lockdown

This morning Queensland Government announced Brisbane would enter a three-day lockdown to stop the spread of the highly contagious UK strain of COVID-19.

Following an Arts Queensland meeting with Cultural Centre CEOs this morning the State Library at South Bank and Cannon Hill will be closed to the public from 3.30pm today until 6pm Monday. All Brisbane-based staff will work from home on Monday.

Carpark

There will be no access to the State Library car park during lockdown, however if staff require access for a building emergency, they should notify their People Leader and email the Facilities mailbox to arrange parking at the Museum car park.

Staff rostered during lockdown period

Staff rostered during this lockdown period will be contacted by their relevant People Leader today regarding arrangements.

Lockdown details

From 6pm tonight until 6pm Monday, people in the local government areas of Brisbane, Moreton Bay, Ipswich, Redlands and Logan will be required to stay at home except:

- to buy essentials like groceries and medicine;
- look after the vulnerable; and
- exercise within their neighbourhood
