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End of Greater Brisbane lockdown

The Premier announced this morning that **the Greater Brisbane lockdown would conclude at midday today.**

Some additional [safety measures are in place](#) throughout Queensland from 12noon today to Thursday 15 April 2021.

Reopening after lockdown

We will reopen our Brisbane sites as follows:

- Infozone will be open to the public from 1pm today and close at 5pm
- All State Library spaces will be open to the public from 10am Saturday 3 April (as per our [public holiday hours](#))
- Anzac Square Memorial Galleries will reopen to the public from 10am Tuesday 6 April.

Front of house staff will be contacted by their People Leader regarding working arrangements for this weekend.

Staff can also return to our South Bank and Cannon Hill offices from today, if required (People Leaders have already contacted relevant staff).

Thank you to everybody who is working today to reopen the Infozone and prepare for our Saturday opening.

Mask up

Throughout Queensland until Thursday 15 April, [you must carry a face mask with you at all times](#) when you leave home, unless you have a lawful reason not to. Children under 12 years and people affected by a medical condition or disability are exempt.

Masks must be worn in indoor spaces, including in libraries. This means that **staff must wear a face mask when they come to the South Bank building** and when working in or moving through front of house spaces (this includes the lifts and foyers — anywhere where the public can go).

Masks do not need to be worn back of house if you can maintain 1.5m from others. However, please carry your mask with you throughout the day so that if you are unable to maintain 1.5m you can put it on.

It is your responsibility to properly use, wear and change your face mask. [More information](#) is available from Queensland Health.

You then need to notify your People Leader and PPL as soon as you receive your results.
