Border restrictions easing at 70% vaccination

On Monday the Premier announced that [restrictions for fully vaccinated people entering Queensland from a hotspot would ease](#) when 70% of eligible Queenslanders are fully vaccinated. Restrictions will ease further when Queensland reaches 80% fully vaccinated, or by 17 December (whichever is earlier).

In order to reach the vaccination targets, and to protect Queenslanders against a predicted rise in cases, the Chief Health Officer is actively encouraging everyone to be vaccinated.
