Changes to face mask rules

After four COVID-19 cases were detected in the community overnight, this morning the Chief Health Officer announced changes to face mask rules.

Please note these rules also **apply to anybody who has recently been in the Brisbane and Moreton Bay** local government areas.

Indoors

You **must wear a mask at all times** when you are indoors, including in workplaces and on public transport.

This means that **masks will be mandatory for everybody** (including visitors) in our front of house public spaces.

Masks can be removed in our back of house workplaces if you can keep 1.5m apart from other people.

Outdoors

You must wear a mask outdoors when you cannot stay 1.5m apart from people who are not part of your household. Masks are also required when you are waiting for public transport at bus stops, taxi ranks or train stations.

While we communicate about the conditions that apply to our visitors and to us as employees, as circumstances can change rapidly remember to check the Queensland Government's [COVID-19 Updates](#) page and [public health directions](#) regularly so that you are across your obligations as a community member.

Health advice

The [active contact tracing alerts](#) have recently been updated. Please check closely and follow Queensland Health advice if you were in the any of the locations at the relevant times.

If you are under advice to quarantine, please email your People Leader and the [People and Culture mailbox](#) **immediately** and **do not come to the workplace**. If your advice from Queensland Health changes, please keep your People Leader and People and Culture informed.

Please continue signing in when you arrive at work:
