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Lockdown lifting in Cairns and Yarrabah

This morning the Premier confirmed that the [lockdown in Cairns and Yarrabah would lift at 4pm today as planned](#).

The **restrictions** already in place in South-East Queensland will also apply to Cairns and Yarrabah until Sunday 22 August (see more detail below).

Cairns colleagues can return to the workplace from tomorrow, but remember you must be wearing a mask at all times in the office. If you have an [exemption for wearing a mask](#) from Queensland Health, you cannot come to the workplace while masks are mandatory.

Making signing in simpler

Based on staff feedback and in consultation with Queensland Health, we have removed the separate Sine Pro site for The Edge.

This means that the **State Library of Queensland** site applies to **both** the main building and The Edge building.

Remember, you still need to sign in and out with Sine Pro when entering and exiting the building. If you are using the mobile app with location services turned on, it will automatically sign you out once you move more than 100m from the building, and prompt another sign in upon your return.

Sine Pro is **in addition** to the requirement from Queensland Health for everybody to check in with the Check In Qld app upon arriving at State Library (South Bank) or Anzac Square Memorial Galleries.

Face masks

Face masks **must cover your nose and mouth and be worn at all times:**

- **Outdoors** (including public transport and rideshare) unless alone or with members of your household; eating or drinking; doing strenuous exercise or if it is unsafe.
- **Indoors (including workplaces, even where physical distancing is possible)** unless it is unsafe or you are working alone in a closed office.

Capacity limits

Indoor spaces are restricted to one person per 4m² and outdoor spaces are restricted to one person per 2m². Check the [State Library capacity tables](#) for the limits in our public spaces.

Ticketed events with allocated seating may proceed at 50% capacity.

Reconsider travel to regional Queensland

My expectation is that all regional travel will be deferred. If you have any work travel planned, please talk with your People Leader.

Eating and drinking

Guests must be seated to eat and drink at The Library Café Pop-Up, or for any events between now and Sunday 22 August.
