Restrictions easing early

This morning Queensland Premier Annastacia Palaszczuk announced that restrictions would ease in Queensland from **6am on Thursday 15 April**. Check the [updated roadmap](#) for full details.

New mask rules

The changes mean that **from 6am tomorrow, masks will no longer be mandatory at State Library**.

You are still encouraged to carry a mask with you when you leave home to wear:

- When travelling on public transport, in a taxi or ride share
- In shopping centres
- In situations where you can't physically distance (indoors or outdoors).

Also, visitors coming to our onsite events are encouraged to wear masks while queuing on entry and exit (particularly for large events in the auditoriums).

Masks remain mandatory in airports and on domestic or international flights departing or arriving in Queensland.

Check In Qld app

We have now rolled out the Queensland Government's new [Check In Qld app](#) at State Library and Anzac Square Memorial Galleries. The app will be used to check in all public visitors.

We will continue to use Sine Pro to check in staff, volunteers, Library Board members, Queensland Library Foundation Council members, contractors and other back of house ("internal") visitors.
