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Work from home extended

The request for non-frontline staff to work from home where possible has been **extended until Friday 4 February**. This will continue to help slow transmission and minimise the risk of disruption to service deliveries.

You may come to the workplace if you need to collect some work or for an activity that is best completed onsite, but you must remember your mask, keep a distance from others and practice good hand hygiene.

Do not come onsite if you are unwell (even with only very mild symptoms). Get tested and stay home.

If you are coming onsite, please continue signing in to assist us with contact tracing efforts if required:

- State Library South Bank (including The Edge, The Library Café Pop-Up and Library Shop) and Anzac Square Memorial Galleries: **sign in with Sine Pro and the Check In Qld app**.
- Cannon Hill and Cairns offices: **sign in with Sine Pro**.

Booster shots

The Chief Health Officer is actively encouraging everyone who is eligible for a booster vaccination (people aged 18+ who had their second dose at least four months ago) to come forward now.

[Find your nearest vaccination location](#) to make a booking, or you can visit a walk-in clinic instead. You do not need to return to where you received your first two vaccinations for your booster shot.

Queensland Health advise the booster is very important for people at greater risk of getting very sick from COVID-19, including:

- people aged 50 years and older
- people with underlying medical conditions

- people living in aged care and disability accommodation
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people
- people who may be at greater risk of COVID-19 because of their work.

The form that recorded your initial vaccination status will be completed by your People Leader following sighting of your proof of vaccination, so please add a new form to record your booster information. You don't need to enter the previously advised vaccination one and/or two information to your new form.

Vaccination required for entry

Don't forget that every person aged 16 years and over who enters State Library and Anzac Square Memorial Galleries, including **contractors** and **volunteers**, must be vaccinated against COVID-19. Please keep this in mind for any visitors you are bringing onsite through the course of your work.

We do not have to check vaccination status of delivery drivers who drop parcels into the dock. Contact-free deliveries are encouraged.
