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Important update to mask rules

This morning, the Chief Health Officer extended stricter mask wearing rules to the **Gold Coast** local government area.

For staff and visitors to our South Brisbane, Anzac Square Memorial Galleries and Cannon Hill premises, **masks are mandatory** indoors, including in our public spaces, in our back of house workplaces and on public transport.

You may remove your mask if you are:

- in a back of house office or a meeting room alone, with the door closed
- eating or drinking
- outside and more than 1.5 metres away from others.

If you cannot wear a mask for lawful reasons, please talk to your People Leader about flexible work options.

Please note these rules also **apply to anybody who has recently been in the Brisbane, Gold Coast and Moreton Bay** local government areas.

The Chief Health Officer emphasised the importance of **high compliance**. If you are unsure about whether you need to wear a mask in a particular situation, **it is best to err on the side of caution and wear one**.

Exposure sites and quarantining

Please continue to **check the [active contact tracing alerts](#) every day** and follow Queensland Health advice if you were in any of the locations at the relevant times. A number of South Brisbane locations have been listed recently.

If you are under advice to quarantine, please email your People Leader and the [People and Culture mailbox](#) **immediately** and **do not come to the workplace**. If your advice from Queensland Health changes, please keep your People Leader and People and Culture informed.

Be prepared

Think ahead and consider what you can do in your teams this week to be prepared should the situation escalate in the coming days. Don't forget to take your work laptops home with you every night.
