This story is for everyone.


It might not cover all you need it to.

Today, I am going to The Corner!




I go through the Infozone.

I hear the Hello Song. I can sing along.




We acknowledge the Country we are on.






We sing, dance and read.






It might be loud.




I can wear headphones.



It might be bright.




I can wear sunglasses.

Someone wants to play with these toys! I can take turns.




I can ask State Library staff for help if I can't find my adult.
