## Open data strategy action plan 2023-24

#### **PURPOSE**

State Library of Queensland champions open access to information and ideas as a key enabler for a strong, well-informed and innovative society through its **Open Data Strategy 2022-24**.

The *Open data strategy action plan 2023-24* outlines activities and processes that will enable State Library to deliver on the strategy and foster

a library culture that openly shares, enables co-creation and enhances innovative service improvement.
