State Library of Queensland will become a giant playground on Saturday 26 April.

The Corner Big Day Out is free for the whole family with activities and performances featuring Justine Clarke and dirtgirl.

The celebrations include the launch of a campaign to raise over \$1 million towards the transformation of The Corner, State Library's popular space for children and families.

Fundraising will support The Corner's move into a new architecturally designed space within State Library focused on encouraging parents and caregivers to talk, sing, read and play with their children.

The Corner's enhancement will make space for messy play and artmaking, a central plaza for group activities, nooks for exploring and tranquil zones.

The new facility will use the latest thinking on children's neurological development through the First 5 Forever program, which is delivered in partnership with local libraries across the state.
